

Christmas Blanket



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What do you need?

Durable Double Four:
 4 x Ivory 326 (i)
 1 x Forest Green 2150 (g)
 2 x Blue VIntage 289 (b)
 2 x Red 316 (r)
 Durable Coral
 1 x Forest Green 2150
 European hooksize 5 or 6, depending on how tight or loose you crochet
 Darnin needle

Terms:

ch = chain
 tr = treble
 sl.st = slip stitch
 dc = double crochet

Start with red. Chain 123.

row 1:

1dc in the second chain from your hook. 1dc in each chain (122)

Row 2 / 17:

1ch (this is to turn your work, it doesn't count as a stitch) Now turn your work. 1dc in each stitch (122)

Row 18:

Change color to Ivory. 1tr in each stitch.

Row 19:

Change color to blue. Start with a dc between the 1st and 2nd tr of the previous row. * 3ch, skip 3 stitches, 1dc between 2tr of the previous row* Repeat *..* until the end.

Row 20:

Color change to Ivory. Start on top of the 1tr of row 18. 3ch (counts as first stitch) *3tr in the 3ch of the previous row* Repeat *..* until the last 3ch bow. 1tr in the last tr of row 18.



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Row 21 / 85 or 94

Mabel is a really loose crocheter and crocheted till row 85.

Frederika is a tight crocheter and crocheted till row 94.

We wanted the blanket to turn into a square. That is why we didn't crochet the same amount of rows. Just try to find out how many rows would be great for you. But if you want the blanket to be longer, you obviously could add as much rows to your blanket as you would like.

Change color to red.

Start on top of the first tr. 1dc in each stitch (122)

Turn your work, 1ch (doesn't count as a stitch) 1dc in each stitch.

Crochet 17 rows like this in **total**.

Let's start crocheting the border now!

Go on with red:

1dc in each stitch. In all the corners you crochet 2dc. At the sides of the blanket you crochet 2dc on each tr and 1dc in each dc.

Change color to green:

1dc in each stitch. In the 2dc from the previous row you crochet 2dc in each of the 2 stitches.

Change color to red:

1dc in each stitch. Now in the corners: 2dc in each 2nd and third stitch of the 2x2 of the previous row.

Change color to green:

1dc in each stitch. Now in the corners: 2dc in each 2nd and third stitch of the 2x2 of the previous row.

Now weave in all yarn ends.



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
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With Durable Coral and a darning needle you start with embroidering the Christmas trees in the red parts of the blanket.

There will be 9 Christmas trees in each red part. You need to start in the 4th dc from the side. Just follow the pattern below and you will be fine!

Now weave in all ends and you're done!
