Materials Needed

Do you want to crochet the big wall hanging? I made this one with double-yarn. You can do this with 2 balls or with 1 ball and then use the beginning and end of the thread. You can make both hangings with one ball.

The size are big wall hanging 36cm x 21cm, the small wall hanging 23cm bij 16cm.

I used budget yarn for this wall hanging, acrylic yarn for needle 4mm. (a ball of 100gr with a length of 241 metres per skein). But you can use all the yarn you want, acrylic, cotton or wool. Use then the crochet hook that fits the yarn. The size of the wall hanging may change when you use other yarn.

- 1 x Grey
- 1 x Green
- Crochet (European) hook size 8 mm for the big hanging
- Crochet (European) hook size 4 mm for the small hanging
- Tapestry needle
- branch of a tree
- optional piece of jute rope

Notes:

Crochet every row from right to left. Don't turn work around, but attaches every row a new thread, and at the end of the row you cast off and weave in ends securely.

You change colors by doing the last passing of your double crochet (dc) with the new color. see photo at the bottom of this page.

US Terms

dc = double crochet

ch = chain

Color changing:



picture 1: the last pass through of your double crochet of the previous color is done with the new color.

picture 2: crochet the next double crochet with the new color.

The wall hanging is crochet in only double crochet (dc) stitches.

At the bottom of the written pattern you will find a crochet diagram, here you can find the color changing.

Row 1

crochet 21 ch

Row 2

crochet 2 ch (counts as first dc), crochet in the 3 ch of the hook needle 1 dc, crochet in each stitch 1 dc (21 dc) make sure you change colors in the right place. Look for the color changing and stitches on the crochet diagram at the bottom. Cast off and weave in ends securely.

Row 3

Attach a new thread. 3ch, 20 dc. (21 dc) make sure you change colors in the right place. Look for the color changing and stitches on the crochet diagram at the bottom. Cast off and weave in ends securely.

Row 4 -20

Repeat row 3, make sure you change colors in the right place. Look for the color changing and stitches on the crochet diagram at the bottom.



Follow this pattern for the color changing, eight section is 1 double crochet (dc). You change colors by doing the last passing of your double crochet (dc) with the new color. Crochet every row from right to left. Don't turn work around, but attaches every row a new thread.
